In addition, she provides consultation and supervision services in area school districts and in private schools. Areas of specialty and interest include: learning differences, learning disabilities, depression, anxiety, divorce issues, and parent-child relationship issues. Dr. Henton serves as a Community Advisor to Scottish Rite Learning Center, and is part of the team of doctors who do assessments for the SRLC.
