Participants in this program will be trained in the methodology developed at the Texas Scottish Rite Hospital for Children (TSRHC). Experts at TSRHC have developed a research-based curriculum, *Take Flight: A Comprehensive Intervention for Students with Dyslexia (Take Flight)*. This curriculum is designed to enable students with dyslexia to achieve and maintain better word recognition, reading fluency and comprehension. It also teaches children with this learning disorder how to apply the reading skills they learn in the classroom to everyday literature.

*Take Flight* contains the five components of effective reading instruction supported by the National Reading Panel and mandated by the federal No Child Left Behind Act: phonemic awareness, phonic skills, vocabulary, fluency and reading comprehension.
