About Dr. Doss:

Dr. Doss did her undergraduate work at SMU and completed her doctorate in speech and language at the University of Texas at Austin. She has worked at the Callier Center for Communication Disorders at Parkland Hospital in Dallas and also has served as adjunct professor in the Department of Communication Sciences and Disorders at the University of Texas at Austin. Currently, she has a private practice as a speech/language pathologist.

Her special interests include late talkers, preschool children with speech, language, and emerging literacy differences, voice disorders and oral myofunctional disorders.

Each testing appointment lasts about two hours. A written report and follow-up meeting will be scheduled approximately three weeks after the testing. The Center implements the assessment model used by the Texas Scottish Rite Hospital for Children in Dallas.
