## **About the Workshop:**

It describes the student, explains the need for alternate modalities, and spends most of the time on specific activities. Ms. Sibley will bring sample activities for "hands-on" opportunities for the participants and teach practical strategies for success in teaching the dyslexic student.

Martha Sibley recently retired from the position of Dyslexia Coordinator at the Luke Waites Center for Dyslexia and Language Disorders at the Texas Scottish Rite Hospital for Children in Dallas, Texas. She is currently serving as Special Consultant to the Dyslexia Therapy Training Program and Dyslexia Education Center at Mississippi College in Clinton, Mississippi. She earned her Bachelor of Science degree in elementary education from this college. She later received a Masters of Education degree in Special Education, with emphases in dyslexia and gifted education, from Texas Woman's University in Denton, Texas. She is a Certified Academic Language Therapist, and is a past president of the Academic Language Therapy Association.

Before she joined the Scottish Rite Hospital staff, Martha served in the public schools for nineteen years as a Title I teacher, regular classroom teacher, and dyslexia therapist. As a part of her responsibilities with the Luke Waites Child Development Center Outreach Staff, Martha traveled throughout the state of Texas providing staff development opportunities and consultation with public schools to assist them in planning services for children with dyslexia. She has also served as a presenter at state, regional, national, and international conferences on dyslexia and learning disabilities.
